Maha Metro Ridership on Continuous Upswing

55,000+ Nagpurians Ride Metro Every Day

Set to Go Up Further



Maha Metro has been registering continuous increase in its ridership. The ridership is on the upswing not just on holidays or weekends, but even weekdays have been recording passenger turnout to the tune of 55,000. Maha Metro had registered a record ridership of 66,428 on 26th June 2022. This figure has broken all previous Ridership records created by Maha Metro before this. The previous best was 60,000 passengers logged on 26th January.

The record ridership is because of extensive co-operation extended by the citizens, while simultaneously, the efforts taken by officials and employees of Maha Metro, under the guidance of Maha Metro MD Dr Brijesh Dixit. Multiple efforts at various levels, as listed below, helped in meeting this target.

- Increased Train Timings The train timings were increased from 6.30 am to 10 pm. The increase in train timings helped metro to cater to the huge section of students who had to rush to school or college in the morning hours. Similarly, the train timings till 10 pm ensure that those working late, especially in the industrial areas of MIHAN or Hingna, could catch the last train to reach their destination. Frequency and train timings were changed keeping in mind the commuters' demand and rush.
- Facilities at Metro Stations: All Maha Metro stations offer a range of facilities
 for commuters. Starting with the ease with which one can enter a station
 using a multiple options like lift, escalator, staircase, Maha Metro stations
 offer unique Automatic Fare Collection (AFC) Gates where a commuter has to
 just tap his ticket or Card to gain entry. Special facilities like tactile flooring
 for diwyang help the specially abled citizens easy access.
- Feeder Service Maha Metro has put a great emphasis on Last and First Mile Connectivity through its Feeder services. The fact that components of Non-Motorized Transport (NMT) like cycle, e-cycle, e-scooter, e-rickshaw have been provided at Metro Stations have given the Metro train commuters to reach their destination easily. This has been helping the students and those working in industrial areas alike.
- Metro Samwad—Right since inception Maha Metro has been focusing on Metro Samwad—the Public Outreach Activity—which aims at reaching out to people and giving details of the project. This has helped in explaining people about the advantages of Metro train travel, giving information about the timings, fare, feeder services and other such aspects. Metro Samwad is conducted in educational institutions, commercial establishments, government, public or private sector offices and at other locations, as per requirement.
- Maha Card & Mobile App The extensive use of Maha Card and Mobile App has played a big role in the enhanced ridership. Realising the need for introducing digital payment, Maha Metro introduced these two concepts. This made Metro travel easy as journey fare could be paid by using these



either Maha Card of Mobile App. Use of Card or App ensures that passenger need not stand in queue for getting a journey ticket.

- Station Ambassador In order to reach area wise locations, Maha Metro honoured and nominated prominent personalities of the city as Station Ambassadors. The prominent personalities helped in spreading the message about Maha Metro and its various aspects. Maha Metro officials helped the station Ambassadors in spreading a word about Metro travel and its various other related aspects.
- Rides Metro Maha Metro conducted of rides various organizations, school students, children, specially-able persons, women to make them aware of the importance of Metro travel. Such rides encourage others to also take up Metro train travel. Similarly other functions and events like Music programmes too were organized at Metro stations to promote Metro Ridership.

Of all Metro Stations, Sitabuldi Interchange – given its strategic location – commands maximum ridership. In fact as much as 20 %-25 % of the total ridership is generated by this station, which enables passengers to shift to Aqua Line from Orange Line and vice versa.

Nagpur Metro has reached a milestone and has crossed the 66,000 mark. With all round efforts being taken by officials, the figure is set to further increase in the coming days as more and more Nagpurians chose to travel by Metro.

Ham, The Astronaut

Ham also known as Ham the Chimp and Ham the Astrochimp, was the first Great Ape launched into space. On January 31, 1961, Ham flew a suborbital flight on the Mercury-Redstone 2 mission from Cape Canaveral, Florida, part of the U.S. space program's Project Mercury.

US space agency National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA) used chimpanzees and other primates to test the Mercury capsule before launching the first American astronauts. Ham's name is an acronym for the laboratory that prepared him for his historic mission — the Holloman Aerospace Medical Center, located at Holloman Air Force Base in New Mexico, southwest of Alamogordo. Ham was born in the French Cameroons, West Africa, in July 1957. He was purchased by the US Air Force and brought to Holloman Air Force Base in New Mexico in 1959.

There were originally 40 chimpanzee flight candidates at Holloman. After evaluation, the number of candidates was reduced to 18, then to six, including Ham. Officially, Ham was known as No. 65 before his flight, and only renamed "Ham" upon his successful return to Earth.

Ham's training began in July 1959. He was taught to push a lever within five seconds of seeing a flashing blue light. To respond properly, he received banana pellets as reward.

On January 31, 1961, the chimp dressed in a mini spacesuit, was launched aboard a Mercury-Redstone rocket. During his sub-orbital flight, computers on the ground measured normal vital signs, letting mission control know the brave chimp was alive. During the mission, the Mercury capsule lost pressure, but Ham was saved by his spacesuit.



He performed his tasks admirably and his capsule touched down safely in the Atlantic at the end of the 16-minute flight. Though he pulled his lever just slightly slower in space than he did on Earth, this feat proved that human motor control was possible in space only when he had safely returned to Earth with nothing worse than a bruised nose.

"A post-flight medical examination found Ham to be slightly fatigued and dehydrated, but in good shape otherwise. Ham's mission paved the way for the successful launch of America's first human astronaut, Alan B. Shepard, Jr., on May 5, 1961," according to NASA's website.

After a thorough medical examination, Ham was transferred to the Washington Zoo in 1963 where he lived until September 25, 1980. He then was moved to the North Carolina Zoological Park in Asheboro.

Ham died on January 17, 1983, at the age of 26. His skeleton was retained for examination by the Armed Forces Institute of Pathology.

His other remains were respectfully laid to rest in front of the International Space Hall of Fame in Alamogordo, New Mexico. The skeleton is held in the collection of the National Museum of Health and Medicine.
